

F. TENNIS COURTS

1. All persons who enter the Tennis Courts do so at their own risk.
2. Key Colony residents, in order to use the courts, must register with the security desk of their building, carry Key Colony residency identification, and show it to the security guard upon request.
3. The courts are for the use of Key Colony residents and their guests only. Guests may play only when accompanied by their resident hosts.
4. Court times are from 7:00 a.m. to sundown.
5. Court reservations for 1 hour periods may be made at the front desk of your building not more than 24 hours prior to playtime.
6. All playing times start at the hour. Court reservations will be held for 10 minutes after the scheduled time.
7. Players must wear tennis clothing – proper shoes and chest covering are required.
8. No playing is allowed when the courts are wet.
9. Pets are not permitted within the court enclosures.
10. Only water and canned non-alcoholic beverages are permitted on the courts – no glass containers, no food, no chewing gum, no smoking.
11. Skateboards, bicycles, and any object that could damage the court surface must be kept out of the court enclosures.
12. No playing against the fence, no racquet abuse, and no foul language.
13. During the hours of 7:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon, the maximum number of persons on the playing surface of a single tennis court shall be four (4) persons.
14. Between 12:00 noon – sundown, group lessons may be conducted on the playing surface of a single tennis court. When making court reservations, a group lesson should be indicated.
